List of Acceptable Trade Matching Utilities

The List of Acceptable Trade Matching Utilities is for the purposes of IIROC Dealer Member Rule 800.49 relating to Broker to Broker Trade Matching. Pursuant to IIROC Dealer Member Rule 800.49, all non-exchange trades involving CDS eligible securities executed between two IIROC Dealer Members are to be reported to an Acceptable Trade Matching Utility. Attached is an updated List of Acceptable Trade Matching Utilities, reflecting the removal of Alpha ATS L.P., because it is now an exchange.

This list supersedes the list included in IIROC Rules Notice 12-0072, issued on February 27, 2012.
