Muzyka</p>	<p>Independent</p>	<p>Professor Muzyka is the Dean and the RBC Financial Group Professor of Entrepreneurship at the Sauder School of Business, The University of British Columbia and is also Dean of the Faculty of Management of UBC Okanagan. Prior to assuming this position in 1999, Professor Muzyka taught and held senior administrative positions at a number of universities and institutions including Harvard, INSEAD, Babson College, Northeastern, Wharton School and Williams College. He worked in industry with General Electric in finance and strategy and was a strategy consultant, primarily with Braxton Associates. In addition, he has acted as a board member and consultant to several other business and not-for-profit organizations such as the Vancouver Board of Trade (Past Chair), GMAC, New Ventures B.C. and the European Venture Capital Association. Professor Muzyka is currently a public director of IIROC. He serves or has served on various Government Councils including The Natural Sciences & Engineering Research Council (NSERC), The B.C. Competition Council, B. C. Premier’s Technology Council, among others. Professor Muzyka has extensive expertise and experience in academics, finance and business and has participated on a number of advisory boards and boards of venture capital corporations as well as not for profit organizations. In November 2008 he was awarded the National Order of Merit by the Government of France (Chevalier de l’Ordre National du Merite). In 2010 he became a Director for GlennRoss PTC Holdings for the Brydson Family Center. Professor Muzyka is a member of the Corporate Governance Committee and the Chair of the Human Resources and Pension Committee.</p>
