Watson Chair in Value Investing at the Rotman School of Management, University of Toronto and teaches a number of investment finance courses including Applied Portfolio Management, Value Investing and Security Analysis. He has written a number of books on investing practices and portfolio building for retail investors and has published extensively in the financial press. He is very active in the financial community and serves on a number of financial and advisory boards and committees. Prof. Kirzner is currently a director and Chair of the Audit Committee of Equitable Trust Inc., and lead external advisor to Hospital of Ontario Pension Plan. Professor Kirzner previously was the Chair of the Issuers and Advisors Committee at the Toronto Stock Exchange, was the Chair of the TSE Special Committee on Market Fragmentation, the Chair of the TIPS and HIPS Discretionary Committee, Public Governor of the Toronto Futures Exchange, director of the Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation and Chair of the Investors Advisory Committee at the Ontario Securities Commission. Professor Kirzner's primary interest is how retail investors make decisions. He is co-developer with Richard Croft the FPX Indexes that have been published daily in the Financial Post since 1997. These indexes are designed as asset allocation benchmarks that allow investors to measure the performance of their portfolios and assess whether there is value added from active management. He is also the author of the retail investor focused Easy Chair portfolio published periodically in the Toronto Star. Mr. Kirzner is a member of the Corporate Governance Committee.</p>
