

Search Tips

Search Notes

1. You must enter a search word. You cannot search without entering a search word.
2. To search for a single word, you must type the word in the space provided and click search
3. To search for multiple words, you can type each word separated by a space in the space provided and click search.
4. To search for a phrase, you must use double quotations around the words.

Example:

If you want to search for "Billy Joe Smith", then you must put double quotations around the entire name. If you do not put double quotations around the entire name, then "Billy", "Joe", and "Smith" will be considered three separate words in the search.

5. You can use Boolean operators (AND, OR, and NOT) and the Proximity Operator (NEAR) to help you in your search.

Example 1:

A search for Billy AND John will return results that contains both **Billy** and **John**

Example 2:

A search for Billy OR John will return results that contains **Billy** or **John**

Example 3:

A search for Billy AND NOT John will return results that contain **Billy** but does not contain **John**

7. Ignored words cannot be searched and will be ignored.
