## **NOTICE TO PUBLIC: DISCIPLINARY HEARING IN THE MATTER OF ZONA PAULETTE ARMSTRONG**

November 27, 2002 (Calgary, AB) – The Investment Dealers Association of Canada announced today that the discipline hearing before the Alberta District Council in respect of matters for which Zona Paulette Armstrong may be disciplined by the Association commenced on November 18, 2002. The hearing has been adjourned to a date to be fixed to allow for Association staff to file written submissions with the Alberta District Council.
