## **New Webcast: Canada's Neighbourhood Financial Health Index**

Prosper Canada and the Canadian Council on Social Development (CCSD) released *Cross Canada Check-Up*, a comprehensive report that highlights provincial/territorial findings from Canada's *Neighbourhood Financial Health Index (NFHI)*, a new composite index measuring household financial health at the neighbourhood level.

IIROC has partnered with Prosper Canada on a multi-year, multi-phased initiative helping the non profit organization explore how disruptive forces are influencing the financial behaviours of Canadians. The report, which is one element of this initiative, examines the overall financial health of households in each province and territory. It also allows for comparisons of financial health and vulnerability, taking into account the following factors: household incomes, liquid assets, real estate assets, consumer debt, mortgage debt and neighbourhood poverty.



This webcast highlights the findings of the report and presents financial data that will be of interest to IIROC registrants.
