## **IN THE MATTER OF Dominick Capital Corporation – Motion**

**October 21, 2020 (Toronto, Ontario)** – A motion has been scheduled before a Hearing Panel of the Investment Industry Regulatory Organization of Canada (IIROC) in the matter of Dominick Capital Corporation (“Dominick”). The motion is for an order terminating and expelling Dominick’s membership with IIROC, following the Protective Order that suspended Dominick’s membership, granted on August 16, 2019 with the consent of Dominick. Dominick effectively has not been operating since the Protective Order was granted.

The motion has been requested to be heard in writing on October 28, 2020. The decision of the Hearing Panel will be made available at [www.iroc.ca](http://www.iroc.ca).

IIROC investigates possible misconduct by its member firms and/or individual registrants. It can bring disciplinary proceedings which may result in penalties including fines, suspensions, permanent bars, expulsion from membership, or termination of rights and privileges for individuals and firms.
