Suspension

Notice of Suspension – Matrix Financial Corporation

Notice is hereby given that, on February 1, 2001, pursuant to By-law 20.30 of the Investment Dealers Association of Canada (“the Association”), the Saskatchewan District Council of the Association (“the District Council”) suspended the rights and privileges of Membership in the Association of Matrix Financial Corporation.

The District Council issued the Order because, on February 1, 2001, the Saskatchewan Securities Commission ordered the suspension of the registration of Matrix Financial Corporation, pursuant to section 134(1)(j) of the *Saskatchewan Securities Act, 1988*.

Matrix Financial Corporation has been suspended because the business operations of the firm have been transferred to Raymond James Ltd, a Member of the Association under an asset purchase agreement and the firm intends to cease carrying business. The Registered Representatives and other investment professionals employed at Matrix Financial Corporation have transferred to Raymond James Ltd., effective February 1, 2001. Arrangements have been made for the orderly transfer of all client assets.
